We are so excited to be joining with the Tennessee State Youth to be a part of their State Youth Convention 2023

The convention will be held in Gatlinburg, TN on March 10th-12th, 2023 at the Park Vista Hotel.

The cost for the convention are as follows:

Registration for SYC: \$100 per person. This includes a t-shirt Hotel: \$135 (Group Rate) per room per night. (4 person occupancy) + tax (12.75% *) This includes one meal

*Tax can be exempt with documentation Misc: Other meals, souvenirs, fudge, etc.

So for each youth, assuming 4 paying people per room, the cost of SYC 23 is \$167.50 plus miscellaneous.

You have 2 Steps for State Youth Convention 2023 (Just a reminder that the dates are Friday, 3/10 - Sunday 3/12)
